

Good afternoon parents, this is Vaughn White, Superintendent of Hesperia Community Schools with an important message.

Parents, as we move forward with remote learning, we understand the need to distribute Chromebooks and meals to our families.

Our process going forward with Chromebook distribution is as follows:

The first round of Chromebook distribution will take place this Thursday and Friday, November 19 and 20, during normal school hours. Parents may come to any of the school offices to pick up one Chromebook per family. Again, in this initial distribution, we are only loaning out one Chromebook per family. We do not have enough devices for every child to have one.

After we have distributed Chromebooks this week, we will assess how many Chromebooks we have left for the second round of distribution that will likely take place beginning Tuesday next week.

Food Distribution: Parents we will have a week's supply of food available for pick up on Thursday, November 19th between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. We will be distributing food out of the high school office entrance only. We ask that you park your car in the parking lot and walk up to the entrance to get food supplies. Please use social distancing if there is a line and of course, we ask that you wear your mask.

I know there will be additional questions as we work through this process and we will continue to update you regarding revised plans or new developments. We appreciate your cooperation. Thank you and have a good evening.
