Good afternoon parents, this is Vaughn White, Superintendent of Hesperia Community Schools with a brief message. The information I am presenting can be accessed on our district webpage under the COVID 19 Badge for further review.

Parents, tomorrow, Thursday, April 16 we will have three important distributions taking place in the district. All of these distributions will take place between 3:00 and 5:00 p.m. and include picking up food, picking up student learning packets and picking up Chromebooks. The first significant item is the timeframe. Our normal food distribution time is from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. It is only tomorrow that this time frame will change to 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. All food distribution after that will continue to take place from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Second, we will be handing out learning packets during this timeframe at each of the school pick-up locations. Kindergarten through 4th-grade students will have packets at the north side of the building at the Bell Tower entrance. 5th through 8th-grade students will have packets at the middle school office entrance on the west side of the building. 9th through 12th-grade students will have their packets at the high school office entrance on the south side of the building. Parents who have children in multiple schools will have to go to each individual site to pick up their child's learning packet. We will be mailing home packets not picked up by parents, so picking them up will save a considerable amount of postage. Parents, for our progress monitoring requirements, completed packets should be dropped off in their original envelope two weeks after receiving them at your child's building location. Please refer to the calendar on the District's webpage for further information.

Third, parents who were unable to pick up a Chromebook for their children on Tuesday and parents that are in need of an additional Chromebook for their family may pick one up during this time. Again, because of limited resources, we are only handing out one Chromebook per family during this timeframe.

Parents, because of the nature of this event, you will have to exit your vehicles to get the packets, food, and Chromebooks. Please adhere to social distancing protocols during this time. We appreciate your patience as we move through this somewhat challenging process.

We hope all of your children get off to a good start with learning Monday. We are all in this together, so if we work together, we can have the best outcome for our kids.
