

Good morning parents, this is Vaughn White, Superintendent of Hesperia Community Schools with a brief message.

Parents, I am calling to remind you that today, Thursday, May 21, from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. is a food distribution day. With Monday being a holiday, there will not be food distribution on Tuesday, May 26th. Students receiving food today will get enough food for 7 days.

Second, contents of lockers will be bagged and tagged with student names for pick-up as part of our Thursday food distribution process on June 4th which marks the end of our school year. This is also the day when Chromebooks must be returned back to the school.

Last, we have set a graduation ceremony date of Thursday, July 16, at 7:00 p.m. Graduation exercises will take place on the football field with graduates and family members practicing social distancing by being in their cars on the field. There will be a very limited number of guests allowed in the bleachers. After the ceremony, the cars (and I am sure they will be decorated) will parade through town as by-standers can wave them on to their new life adventures.
