Board Discussion

The following items were discussed:

- The parking lot repaving project was discussed. We will have three bids for the July 18th meeting. We will be asking the vendors for reasonable assurance that the projects will be completed before the start of school.
- The systems of communications with the Superintendent were discussed. Vaughn White, Superintendent, explained to the board the Board Action Matrix form. He also discussed the methods of communication that he will be using to communicate emergency items and regular items. It was suggested that text messages be sent to board member's cell phones for emergency items along with phone calls, and e-mail. Student safety will be a priority in emergency situations with communication to board members and others happening after student safety has been determined. If a board member has a request for information, they should request all of the information from the Superintendent, who will respond and then share the information with all board members.
- Board goals are starting to be compiled. Workshop time may need to be used to work on board goals and to formulate a strategic plan as a long term goal.
- The NEOLA Board Policy review has begun and will be a process that will be on going during the school year.
- The Grand Valley Automation contract will need to be reviewed as to the benefit of having the contract and will need to be reviewed before it is renewed.
- The Reading Bus is going well. Fifty students attended last week.
